The improvements to the Icknield Way will provide a new cycle commuting route to Wantage and Grove from the Harwell Campus as well as a community ammenity. Both Wantage, Grove and the Campus are growing and the route is required to provide a direct cycle route as an alternative to car use and cycles using the A417.

Motor vehicles and horse drawn carriages will damage the type of surface proposed for the route. This will result in increased maintenance costs and / or cyclist not using the route, which will defeat the reason for upgrading the route and fail to meet the County Council's policy of increasing transport choices and reducing the reliance on motorised transport.
